The Allegheny Valley School District follows the guidelines of the National School Breakfast and Lunch Program for the state of Pennsylvania.

<u>Community Eligibility Program</u>: Students may participate in school breakfast and lunch program without having to pay a fee or submit an eligibility application. No further action is required by you.

*Students who wish to purchase a second entrée, a snack or beverage option, or just milk must pay for those selections. Community Eligibility Program does not include Ala Carte items. Charging the sale of those items will not be permitted.

Parent/Guardians are responsible for any *carryover* or *current meal charges* incurred prior to the start of this school year. Information on Meal Charging policies and Debt Collection procedures may be found at <u>www.avsdweb.org/</u>. Having adequate funds for the purchase of ala carte and extras items is required.

For your convenience the district has implemented a credit card pre-payment system. Parents will now be able to:

- Set-up automatic recurring payments by date or by balance.
- View student account balances online.
- Request e-mail notification when their child's balance falls below a certain point.

Parents can use the link on the district's website or log in to **www.payschoolscentral.com** to register their new account.

The Food Service Department would like to remind parents and students that the cafeteria provides an extensive *BREAKFAST* program. Research shows that kids who eat breakfast have increased attendance and performance. Breakfast is the most important meal of the day!
