Notes from Dr. Graczyk:

Teachers began the 2020-2021 school year this week with several days of professional development. The staff is excited to start the school year and working very hard to have a smooth transition throughout the coming months, In addition, the following items are important as we virtually welcome students back to school:

- Securing supplies Personal Protective Equipment (masks, face shields, etc.) were ordered and have been delivered.
- Technology Most of the personal technology for students has been received and distributed; some items remain on back order.
- Food Service items Information on meals for students while on virtual learning is posted on the web site: www.avsdweb.org.

Some items remain fluid:

- The Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA or Act) The District continues to review the law and any applications from employees. This law may create a shortage of staff to work in the schools.
- The District continues to work on transportation and encourages any parent/guardian that will provide their own transportation to AND from school to complete the brief survey. This information is also posted on the web site: www.avsdweb.org.
- The guidelines surrounding sports and events continues to change. The District will comply with all county and state criteria as it pertains to athletics. Updates will be posted on the web site and sent out via DYNAmail as decisions are made.

As we approach the new school year, we look at this unique opportunity to not only educate, but to learn from each other. Together we can make this year a memorable and positive one for students, staff, and families. Together we can overcome challenges. Reopening of School

- The committee continues to meet to review the plan and make any necessary updates.

Q: When phased in learning occurs, will students in the same families be scheduled on the same days to attend the buildings?

A: That is the intent, parents should talk with their child's administrator, and District officials will work to have the students attend on same days.
